POLICY REGARDING INSPECTION OF RECORDS

The General Property Tax Act (Excerpt) Act 206 of 1893

211.10a Assessment rolls and appraisal cards; inspection and copying.

All property assessment rolls and property appraisal cards shall be available for inspection and copying during customary business hours.

Interested persons can inspect and/or copy records at the assessor's office located at the address above either by appointment, or during the assessor's regular posted office hours.

Assessor Record Cards are also posted on the Bergland Township website annually, after the close of the March Board of Review.

Alternatively, interested persons can inspect and/or copy records at the Ontonagon County Equalization Department Monday-Friday 8:30am-4:30pm (closed for lunch 12pm-1pm), located at the Ontonagon County Courthouse:
